- Attend meetings and/or events with Experience Waterloo staff.
- Support Experience Waterloo staff and perform administrative tasks as needed.

Requirements

- Must be enrolled in a college or university (sophomore level or higher preferred).
- Strong interpersonal, written and verbal communication skills.
- Ability to work in a multi-task environment and see projects/tasks through to completion.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office Systems.
- Maintain professional appearance and behavior.
- Valid driver's license (some driving required).

Duration of Internship

Internship duration is a maximum of one semester. Interns can work up to 40 hours per week within the Experience Waterloo's office hours of 8am-5pm, Monday thru Friday. Participation in activities/events beyond normal office hours may be required. In addition, interns receive a stipend and reimbursement for mileage.
